The IMF invites applications for the following position:

## Research Assistant

The Research Assistant (RA) position is intended for recent graduates with a bachelor's degree from leading universities and superior academic records, who would like to gain useful work experience in an international environment before pursuing further studies or moving on to other employment opportunities. The RA supports the operational and policy work of STI management and economists and provides back-up services to the STI's Information Technology (IT) officer. The position offers the opportunity to interact with experienced IMF economists, gain a comprehensive understanding of the economic and financial policy challenges facing Asian countries, and supplement academic training with practical, policy-oriented, knowledge. The appointment is for two years.

### The RA will typically be called on to do the following:

- Research, collect, and compile information on economic and financial issues to support STI training and research activities.
- Maintain and update quantitative and qualitative economic, financial, and statistical databases. Design systems to facilitate interface between external and in-house databases.
- Prepare presentations and databases to be used in STI training activities.
- Provide IT support to end-users and help maintain the IT network.

### Requirements:

- Completion of a Bachelor's degree in economics, business, mathematics, or statistics.
- A cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 in the principal field of study and in the overall program. Final academic transcripts must be submitted prior to appointment.
- Strong knowledge of, and a high degree of comfort with, Excel and PowerPoint.
- Familiarity with econometrics software, such as Stata and Eviews, would be beneficial.
