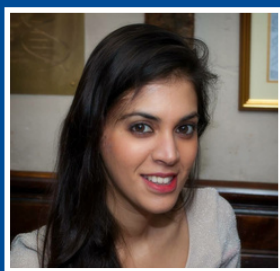

### ✓ Abstract

This presentation will focus on the key issues facing the Chinese economy today, drawing from the work done for the recently published 2024 IMF Article IV consultation with China. The presentation will outline the economic outlook and risks amid weak domestic demand following the continuing real estate contraction and intensifying fragmentation. It will discuss the key policy recommendations to support domestic demand as well as recommendations for upgrading policy frameworks. It will also touch upon medium-term policies to reignite sustainable growth, and conclude with a discussion of trade fragmentation and external spillovers.
